



Information Protection Policy

Leap for Literacy commits to protecting any information concerning an individual's identity in accordance with FERPA regulations. Leap for Literacy will not give, sell, or share any information with any other party.

What information do we collect?

To participate in the Read'n Roll, the following information must be collected to create individual accounts for families and teachers:

- Contact information (student name, parent name, email address)
- Student's date of birth

This information is only accessible to the student's teacher, school administration, and Leap for Literacy.

Why do we collect this information?

We request the above information for the following reasons:

- Last names are required to create their accounts to track their reading and kind acts progress.
- Birthdays are needed to send a birthday wish to the student on the Read'n Roll platform.
- Parent email addresses are used to create the username for the family account. We also want to encourage family engagement, and we would like to communicate with the parents about their child's progress when school is not in session.

Are there alternatives to sharing this information?

While all shared information is safe and secure, Leap for Literacy can take extra steps to further protect your students' information by making a few adjustments:

- Instead of using a student's last name, we can enter students into the system using the teacher's last name or the school's name. Example: *Aimee TuckerElementary*
- Instead of using a student's date of birth, we can enter fake birthdays for each student.
- Instead of using a parent's email address for the username, we can create a username using other information.
